



Use of buprenorphine via trans-mucosal route

- Buprenorphine is an opioid medication for pain relief.
- It is to be given via the mouth onto the mucous membranes.
- Insert the syringe into your cat's mouth towards the cheek and administer the whole syringe.
- Make sure you give this medication 30 minutes before any food.
- You **CANNOT** add this medication to the food as it will not work.
- This medication is a controlled substance and should be treated with caution.
- If any of the medication gets on your skin, in your eyes or you accidentally ingest it, please wash it off immediately and seek medical attention.
- Make sure you keep this medication out of the reach of children and other pets.
- Please return all used and unused syringes to us using the bag provided.
